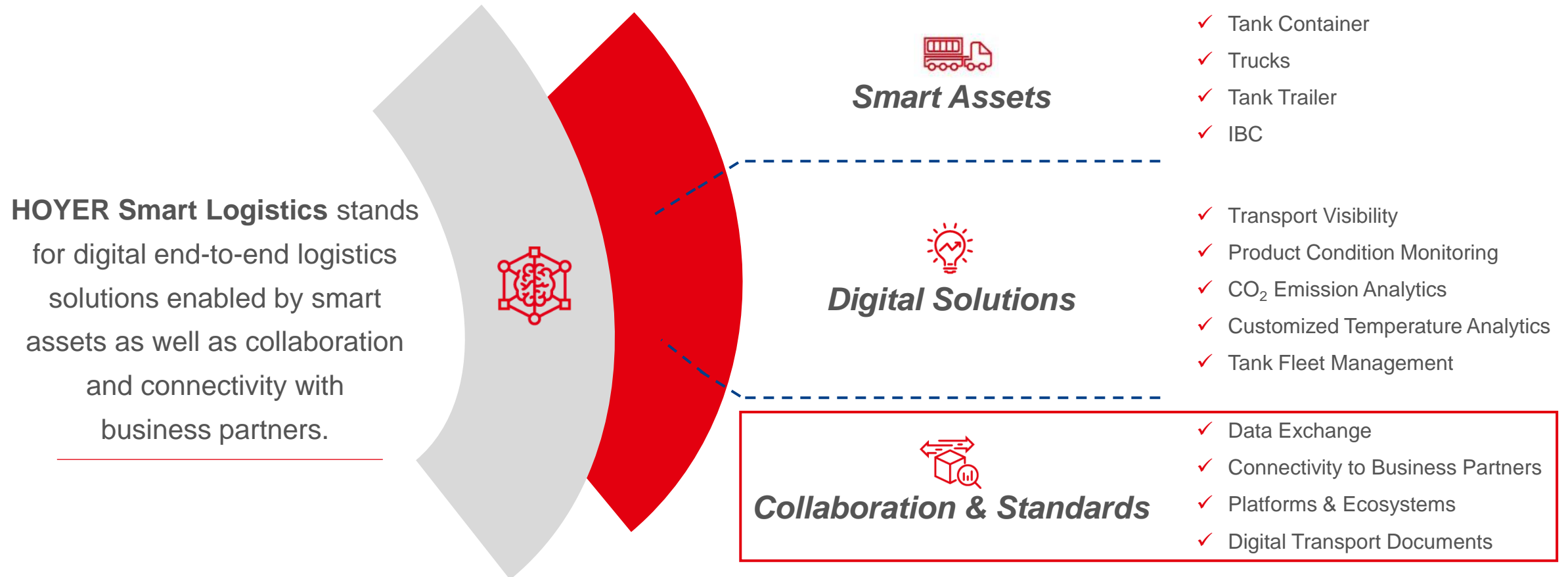

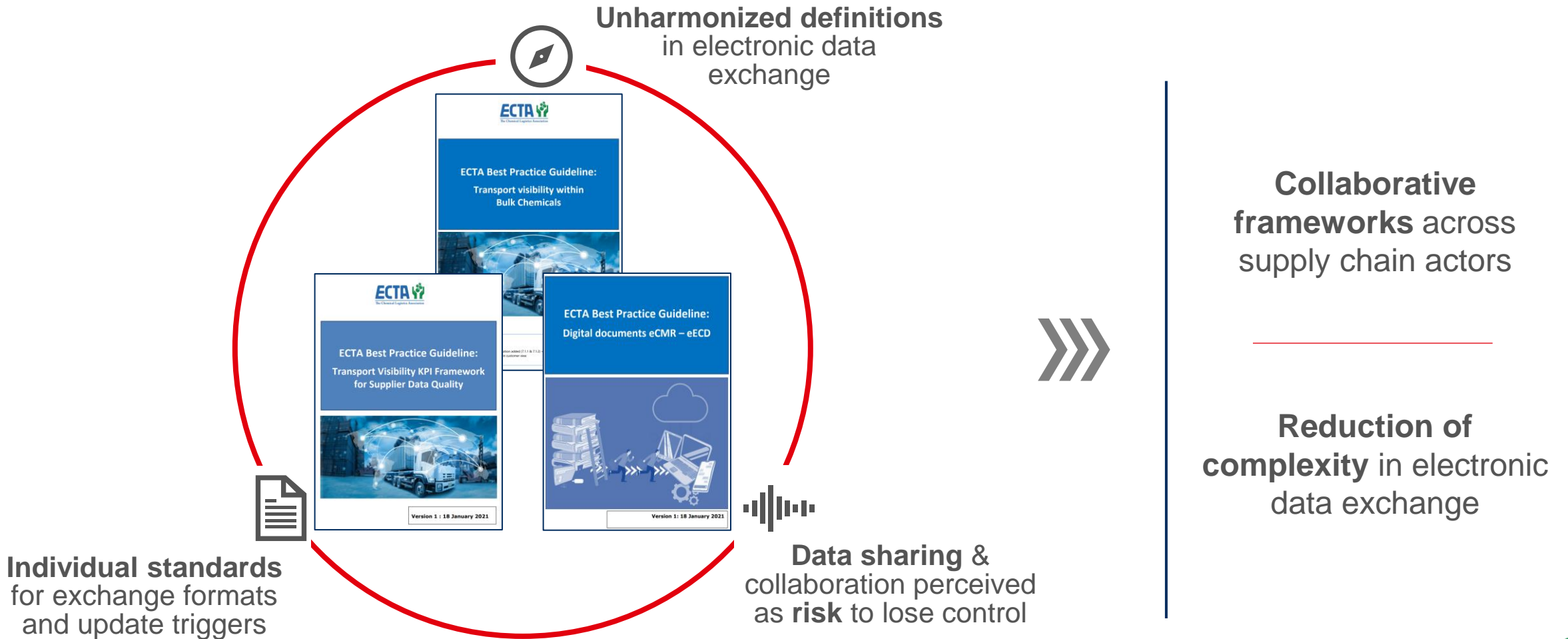

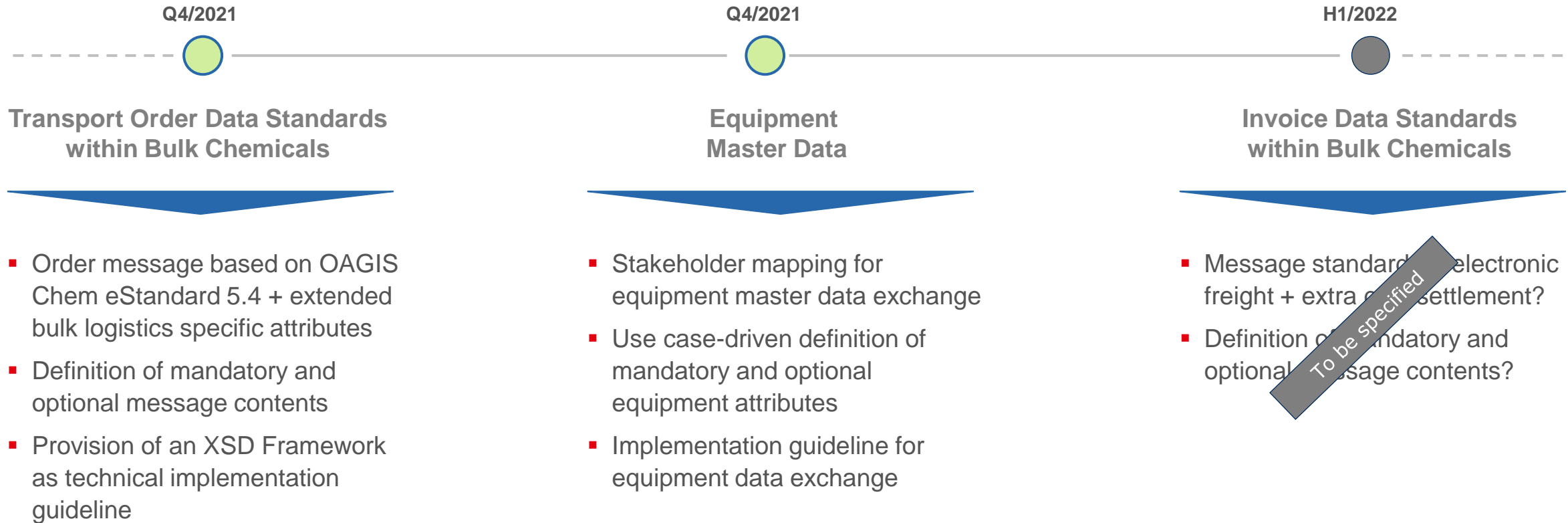


KPI Framework for Supplier Data Quality
